2001 Fairline Targa 34 with twin 260 hp Volvo Penta KAD44/DP EDC diesel engines and full service history (engines and stern drives last serviced in October 2023). A fully maintained and well presented example of these very popular family sports cruisers, renowned for their classic Fairline lines, performance and spacious accommodation. Impressive inventory with numerous recent upgrades including cockpit camper cover, tender, liferaft, radar / chartplotter, DSC VHF radio, AIS and cockpit upholstery. Early inspection recommended.

ACCOMMODATION

- Comfortable cherry wood interior with accommodation for 4 / 6 in 3 cabins including saloon
- Master cabin forward with large double berth
- Separate heads compartment to starboard with Jabsco electric flushing marine toilet, wash-hand basin, shower and shaver socket
- Spacious saloon with dinette arrangement to port (converts to occasional double berth)
- Galley opposite equipped with s/s sink (new mixer tap in 2020), Engel fridge / freezer, Eno 2 burner gas hob and Smev gas oven / grill (gas system serviced / updated in July 2020)
- Aft cabin with twin single berths, seat and vanity unit / wash-hand basin
- Opening deck hatches and portlights in all cabin provide adequate ventilation
- Companionway steps up to open teak self-draining cockpit (new upholstery in June 2020) with raised helm and passenger seating forward
- Step down to aft 'U' shaped seating area with table to port (infill converts to sun bed)
- Additional seat and wine / drinks cooler opposite
- Transom gate to starboard leading to integral teak boarding platform with s/s folding bathing ladder
- Ample stowage throughout boat including hanging lockers in both cabins and large open top locker in engine compartment
